

The atheist says that the right to kill the unborn is location, location, location. If the child requires the mother's womb to live and she doesn't want to share it with him, she may abort. 2 and 3. The unwanted unborn is called "fetus" or "blastocyst" or "a glob of tissue" while the wanted unborn is called "baby": "Baby on board!" reads the T-shirt. Then to dehumanize them further they are compared to animals: vermin, insects, or diseases to be exterminated. "Babies are loud, smelly, and expensive. Unless you want one..." says Planned Parenthood.

4. The state organizes and promotes abortion in the public schools and in doctors offices.

5. Extremists drive groups apart with hateful propaganda forcing the pro-lifers to defend the worth of all the unborn. Once you consciously admit that there is no difference biologically between a wanted and an unwanted unborn, polarization is impossible.

6. Victims are identified by group and separated in preparation for stage 7: extermination. Extermination quickly becomes mass killing or genocide. Once society sees the unwanted as fully human, then the 49 million dead are seen as an holocaust. 8. is the denial that anything that terrible is happening. tp
